## Showing At WEF This Year... Show+™ has you covered

It's no news to equestrian athletes that accidents are bound to happen at some point in their careers both in and out of the saddle. Whether it is a rider injury due to a fall or a horse must be scratched from classes due to an illness or injury, wouldn't it be reassuring to know there are protections in place to lower the financial risks of competing in the sport you love?

New this year, competitors for the 2020 Winter Equestrian Festival and the 2020 Adequan® Global Dressage Festival are going to have the option to be more protected than ever due to the launch of a revolutionary new program called Show+™. Show+™ was developed and is licensed by CaptiveOne Advisors®. CaptiveOne Advisors® feels strongly about protecting the passions of its clientele. Show+™ does just that. Equestrian Sport Productions intends to implement the program for the first time in 2020.

If your horse is registered to compete in classes at any 2020 WEF or 2020 Global Dressage show, you are eligible for reimbursements should your horse suffer from accident, injury or illness that requires urgent medical care and/or which results in its sudden death or humane euthanasia. Your horse is automatically enrolled in Show+™ when you register to compete each week and your show/entry fees are paid, but you can revoke such enrollment before your horse competes in its first class of any given show. Entries where enrollment in Show+™ has not been revoked are considered "Covered Animals." Likewise, should a person suffer any injury or fatality while riding a Covered Animal, you (or your estate) will be eligible for reimbursement to help defray your medical costs, including ambulatory transportation. As a rider, you will also be eligible to receive a credit to your account for any class and entry fees you've already paid and you're forced to scratch due to such illness or injury. Conditions and caps apply; and a verified incident report would be required to be completed. Horses must be between the ages of 3 years and 20 years. Coverage is managed per horse/per show.

# What does Show+™ Cover

## Equine Protections

**How it Works:** If your horse is registered to compete in classes at any 2020 WEF or 2020 GDF show, you are eligible for reimbursements should your horse suffer from accident, injury or illness that requires urgent medical care and/or which results in its sudden death or humane euthanasia. Your horse is automatically enrolled in Show+™ when you register to compete each week and your show/entry fees are paid, but you can revoke such enrollment before your horse competes in its first class of any given show. Entries where enrollment in Show+™ has not been revoked are considered “Covered Animals.” Upon receipt of a verified incident report involving a Covered Animal, the company will pay reasonable and customary veterinarian fees for covered surgical procedures, medical treatment or diagnostic testing provided to your horse due to an accident, injury, lameness condition, or illness. Conditions and caps apply. Eligible horses must be between the ages of 3 years and 20 years. Coverage is managed per horse/per show. A verified incident report must be filed with the Show Office if reimbursement is sought under Show+™.

### A. Equine Mortality

Any mortality payment would be a fixed, capped amount and is meant to supplement, but not exceed, any established value that may exist under your own equine mortality insurance policy.

**Does Cover:** • Fatal/catastrophic injury • Sudden death • Humane destruction

**Does Not Cover:** • Post-mortem exams/necropsy (mortality claims will require this for pay-outs).

### B. Injuries and Illness

Urgent medical costs are capped, at which point the Covered Animal’s connections would be solely responsible

**Does Cover:** • Colic surgery • Fractures • Bone chip removal • Emergency transport Fees • Laceration Repair • Pneumonia • Shipping fever • Colic/ Hospitalization • Lameness • Laminitis • Soft tissue injury • Farm Call Charges • Radiographs • Bone Scans • MRI & CT • Bloodwork • Scintigraphy

**Does Not Cover:** • Routine/ Maintenance Costs • Joint Injections • Vaccines/ Annual Exam • Post-mortem exams/ necropsy • Dental Floating • Homeopathic/ Alternative Medicine • Acupuncture • Chiropractic work and Massage Therapy • Experimental procedures • Therapeutic Lasers • Magnetic Therapies • Shock wave • Elective Surgeries • Castration • Respiratory Surgery • Cosmetic Surgery • Disease Outbreak

### C. Medically Necessitated Scratch

If you’ve paid various class and entry fees, we will credit your account for all of class costs associated with same day and future-day scratches should you be required to scratch your horse due to illness, injury, or death. We will not cover nomination fees or stall fees that were required for entry. A veterinarian certificate will be required. Scratches not mandated due to the health problems of the horse are not eligible for credit. A veterinarian certificate from the Horse Show’s Official Veterinarian will be necessary for all same-day scratches. FEI scratches may only get a portion of their fees refunded by ESP.

## Rider Protections:

**How it works:** Should you suffer any injury or fatality while riding a Covered Animal, you (or your estate) will be eligible for reimbursement to help defray your medical costs, including ambulatory transportation. As a rider, you will also be eligible to receive a credit to your account for any class and entry fees you’ve already paid and you’re forced to scratch due to such illness or injury. A doctor’s certification will be required. Excludes pre-existing conditions, elective or routine health procedures. Conditions and caps apply.

\*\*This page is for informational use only to help you understand this new program. ESP reserves the right to cancel the Show+™ program. Forms are available in the WEF and GDF show offices. Payment in full of all show and office fees must be made before a claim could be valid. Entries who’ve revoked enrollment in Show+™ will be tracked each week based on back numbers. Equestrian Sports Productions is not liable for any claim amount paid or not paid.

The undersigned is responsible for any and all entries itemized below when picking up the Officially Issued Back Numbers for each series from the WEF or GDF show offices. All authorized representatives must have a current signature on file. Inquiries about Show+™ or the entry process can be made to the persons identified on-line or in the show office.

**Enrollment is made on a weekly basis once classes are entered and expires at midnight after the Covered Animal’s last class of that week. The rider protections begin on a weekly basis once classes are entered AND expire after the Covered Horse’s last class of that week and/or the Covered Horse is scratched for that week for any reason.**

REFUND AND CREDIT CARD POLICY

Stabling, nominating and administration fees will not be refunded under any circumstances. Horses entered may be scratched without a veterinarian's certificate by notifying the Show Secretary in writing via letter, official scratch sheet, or other written correspondence, provided. Written notification is received before the start of competition, entry fees will be refunded, less a \$150 processing fee. We encourage you or your agent/trainer to close out your show bill in person before the end of the show. However, if you do not do so in person, you automatically agree to authorize Equestrian Sports Productions to charge your credit card for all entry fees, stabling fees, etc. If you dispute a charge made by Equestrian Sports Productions you may not be able to show until the charge dispute has been resolved.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a horse in the United States Federation of Equestrian Sports (USEF) Competition, I agree that I am releasing, waiving, defending, and holding harmless the Federation, its directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules, Regulations and Bylaws of the Federation and/or participate under the Rules, Regulations and Bylaws of the Federation. I also agree that as a condition of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition (Equestrian Sport Productions) may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, firm, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition, for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Federation, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following: I AGREE that the "Federation" and "Competition" as used herein includes the Licensee and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates. I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death. ("Harm"). I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Federation and the Competition from all claims, for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others; even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition. I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition and to indemnify that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by the Federation and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I have read the Federation Rules and the Competition and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition/ I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Federation on the official USEF accident/injury report form. BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE to be bound by all applicable Federation Rules and all terms and provisions of this Prize List. If I am signing and submitting this Agreement electronically, I acknowledge that my electronic signature shall have the same validity, force and effect as if I affixed my signature by my own hand.
