Neither the show committee/staff, the show, SOUTH FLORIDA HUNTER JUMPER ASSOCIATION, EQUESTRIAN SPORT PRODUCTIONS, LLC, LITTLEWOOD FENCES, INC., STALL WATCH, the show manager, the show sponsors, any show officials, nor any sanctioning body will be responsible for any accident, damage, loss or injury to mount, owner, rider or other persons or property. Management reserves the right to modify any policy or rules set forth in the prize list in an emergency situation which may require modification or restrictions for the welfare of the horse or rider. Management reserves the right to update this electronic prize list by revision date. Any changes will be announced by eblast, announcements and signage posted in the office. Changes in Covid-19 safety protocols and restrictions may be updated by Management at any time necessary.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

HARD HAT RULE

It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience. The Competition will uphold all rules listed under GR801.

SAFE SPORT

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

SAFE SPORT

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

As per COVID-19 protocol, all entry forms, releases and method of payment must be established. Once all forms are received (either online or in person) and processed, you will be assigned a back number that will only be used at the SFHJA Charity Horse Show. We strongly recommend that you enter the classes that you plan to show in for all days and shows. Please do not expect ring capacity to allow for adds to be accepted the day before.

1) ALL FEES MUST BE PAID IN U.S. FUNDS

2) The following fees must accompany the entry form for each show entered: Stall and/or non-stabling fees & Nomination fees.

3) The following will be considered POST: (a) Entries not accompanied by the fees shown, (b) Entries with no class numbers, (c) Entries postmarked and/or submitted after the closing date and must be accompanied by a \$25 post entry fee per horse.

4) Entry fees or open blank check or credit card number should be sent with the entry blank.

5) Back numbers will not be given out without the following: (a) SIGNED OPEN CHECK or SIGNED CREDIT CARD AUTHORIZATION FORM for each show submitted to the horse show secretary, (b) all OWNERS, RIDERS and TRAINERS/COACHES have signed the entry blank. One number will be assigned for each horse and will stand for the show series (Prize List).

6) Entries with incorrect numbers may be excused from the ring.

7) All accounts must be settled after each show. Open checks will be filled out and/or credit cards will be run within one (1) hour of the completion of the show.

By having a signed entry blank you are agreeing to have the credit card on file charged for any applicable show fees.

USEF FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT.

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of SFHJA 72nd Annual Charity Horse Show (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4. BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time, as well as all terms and provisions of this Prize List. If I am signing and submitting this Agreement electronically, I acknowledge that my electronic signature shall have the same validity, force and effect as if I affixed my signature by my own hand.

POST ENTRIES (ACCEPTED ON A VERY LIMITED BASIS)

Please remember due to current COVID-19 procedures, management is trying to give exhibitors accurate showing times. Post entries, late and same day adds create the biggest challenge for giving accurate information when additional rounds cannot be predicted after closing dates. Post entries MAY be accepted at the sole discretion of management before any scheduled class that is scheduled in a ring that has not reached the limit capacity unless otherwise indicated. Entries not adhering to the entry procedure above will be post and will pay a \$25 post fee. Post entries are meant to be a deterrent to being late. They are not just a way for the show to make money. Closing date is November 15th, 2022.

SHOW PASS FEES & HORSE REGISTRATION

For those exhibitors who are not current members of the USEF a \$45 fee for USEF and \$30 for USHJA will be added to each entry. In addition each horse regardless of whether the owner is a current member of the USEF or USHJA must pay a \$75 horse registration fee to the USHJA. Forms will be available in the office. You can go to www.ushja.org for more information. Those exempt from these fees are listed in GR901.9 1-9. (Exception: USEF Opportunity and Academy Classes and Local rated competitions)

OPPORTUNITY CLASSES

All Opportunity classes will be held in accordance with GR821. Riders/drivers/handlers entered only in these classes are exempt from the Federation membership requirements and are not required to pay a non-member fee but are required to list the Federation membership number if the participant is a member.

GOLF CARTS, SCOOTERS & OTHER VEHICLES

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

COMBINING & SPLITTING SECTIONS

Sections that are scheduled as split sections will be combined following current USEF rules. All USEF Federation rules for combining Rated sections will be in effect. If you are interested in sponsorship contact show management the day before the section is started to avoid last minute changes. The show will be in compliance of HU 161. Please note classes will not be re-divided after close of entries at 4 p.m. the day before the section starts. Any entry and accepted after the closing time will not be calculated in the minimums for splitting.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES

Management will not refund entry fees for days or classes that commence and are canceled due to severe weather, an emergency or some other act of God. If the entire show is canceled due to severe weather or an emergency, management will refund those class fees.

FOUND SHOWING IN CLASS NOT ENTERED

Any exhibitor found showing in any class in which he/she has not been entered will be fined \$35 plus the post entry fee for that class.

DOGS/PETS

Pets can transmit disease! Please note that loose dogs or pets will be dealt with very seriously in the Covid-19 protocols and may subject the owner(s) to immediate expulsion. Dogs/Pets are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs/pets on a leash while mounted. Dog/Pet owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Chapters 6 and 7, as well as issuance of warning cards. GR1301.6 Any dog/pet that is found loose will be detained by the show until a fine is paid. Any dog /pet that disrupts an exhibitor's round will be required to pay the exhibitor for that round plus a \$100 fine to the show. Also, please dispose of all dog/pet waste in the proper containers. Management reserves the right to evict and/or bar future entry to any dog (or pet) that displays aggressive behavior towards people or other animals. Dog or pet owners will be held financially and legally responsible for any injuries caused by their pets.

SCRATCH POLICY

Scratches must be received in the show office before the start of the class. Scratches will not be given a refund where a posted order has been set. Please remember that entries have been limited to others based on your entry or nomination to show. Scratches accepted for credits must be done timely & in accordance to the current Covid-19 horse show operating procedures.

BACK NUMBERS

Riders MUST wear the back number provided by SFHJA for that horse unless prior arrangements have been made, i.e., lost number, etc. **European bridle or breastplate numbers will not be accepted as the only form of a number. If riders fail to have show-issued number on their back or pinned to their saddle pad in plain view, rider may be eliminated from the class. Any participant using our online entry system still needs to come to the show office to obtain a show-issued number.**

STABLING

All stabling requests should be requested by email to: stabling@wellingtoninternational.com or by texting Hali Miller at (954) 591-9096 or Julie Burton at (561) 239-5271. Stabling will only be offered to those who correctly fill out entries as described in the entry process. Once exhibitors are assigned numbers, the availability of stalls will be opened. Signage in both English and Spanish are placed on every exterior aisle entrance. Stall reservations and payments are due no later than one week prior to show. All stabling is subject to 7% tax. Stabling will be \$275. Post stalls if available will be an extra \$25. Entry is required with stall reservation. Stalls will be ready by 8:00am on Tuesday November 22nd unless previous arrangements have been made. Stalls are permanent wood structure and are 10 x 12 with doors and matted floors, along with Vinyl 10 x10 with doors. They will be assigned as entries accompanied by stall fees are received. First bedding is not included. If you want bedding delivered to your stall aisle you must contact Gold Coast Feed at 561-793-4607. All trash is to be placed in the receptacles provided, not in the manure bins. All manure is to be put in the area provided. All above fees are plus 7% sales tax. Please read all of your responsibilities and required materials for operating in the barn areas in the SFHJA Covid-19 protocol action plan.

GROUNDS FEE

All NON STABLED entries will be charged a grounds fee of \$50. This charge will be put on all horses not paying a stall fee to SFHJA. This includes horses who have paid for the ESP 6 Month Stall Plan. This charge will be automatic to any horse or pony not paying a stall fee to the show. Exception will be allowed for any deadline entry.

FEED & BEDDING

Feed & Bedding will be available by Gold Coast Feed (561-793-4607). No other feed or bedding vendor will be permitted on the show grounds due to insurance and liability requirements, without the express permission of management. Exhibitors wishing to use another vendor do so at their own risk and must receive permission for that vendor to come on the grounds. Storage of feed, bedding, hay, etc. must be within the stall space only. No straw will be allowed without a charge for its separate removal and waste storage

CHAMPION & RESERVE

Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in all Hunter Sections. The awards will be made to two of the four horses that have acquired the most points in the over fences classes. In addition to these points, only those four horses shall receive full points for ribbons won in the Under Saddle Class. Points will be awarded on the basis of 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, 1/2 for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th places respectively. All classes are full point classes, except MODEL classes which are 1/2 point classes. Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in all Jumper sections on the basis of points in accordance with JP110.2, Ties to be broken by Highest Placing in the Classic. A Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in the Equitation Section and in accordance with EQ106.86.a with the top two riders with the most points being eligible.

SCHOOLING

Schooling fences will be provided in designated schooling areas. At all times on the grounds social distancing protocols will be enforced. No more than one person per schooling standard may be next to any jump and only on opposite sides. Please remember that schooling fences are a commonly touched surface. SFHJA Covid-19 protocols require gloves when handling these fences. There will be organized schooling the day before each show week in the rings at the rate of \$50 per round. No jumps may be touched during these schooling sessions except by SFHJA personnel. Ring occupancy will be limited by ingate personnel to achieve social distancing protocols. The schooling area footing has been designed for longevity between watering & maintenance drags. It is not designed for sharp turns or lunging. Absolutely NO LUNGING is allowed in the schooling area. **ENTRY'S (HORSE) SFHJA BACK NUMBER MUST BE WORN TO SCHOOL (NO EXCEPTIONS). EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR HORSE(S) NUMBER AND THE NUMBER IS FOR THAT HORSE'S USE ONLY. ANYONE SCHOOLING WITHOUT AN OFFICE- ISSUED BACK NUMBER IS TRESPASSING, MAY BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR VIOLATING COVID-19 PROTOCOLS, AND WILL BE REPORTED TO THE USEF FOR FURTHER DISCIPLINARY ACTION.**

PRIZE MONEY

Prize money will be credited to the entry's show account after the results of the class winnings are posted or a check will be mailed to the owner at the address on the entry blank within thirty days after the show, thereby ending the show's responsibility. Any class that has a number of entries required, will have the payout based on the number of on time entries and post entries will not be included in the number used to determine the payout. Classes that do not have enough entries to pay out prize money will either be canceled, or run without prize money at the exhibitors option. Any jumper class with less than 4 entries will not pay prize money and entry fee will be as listed. .NO Prize money will be awarded without a Social Security number or Federal Tax ID number on file. We require W-9s or W8-BEN forms for all prize money recipients.

POLING

We do not allow any sort of manual poling or poling of any type on the competition show grounds.

CHECK OUT POLICY

In the Covid-19 protocols, office capacity is limited to a maximum of 5 people (in addition to SFHJA secretaries and management) allowed in the office at any time. We strongly encourage all of our exhibitors to use our online check out service. Exhibitors who do not check out either in the office or online by 24 hours after the completion of the show may be charged a surcharge of \$10 per entry. This charge would be applied only if prior arrangements have not been made. The web service is available for use anytime during or after the show. If you need help checking out online feel free to contact us by phone or email (Hali Miller at casey255@gmail.com). The show office will be closed one hour after the close of competition.

BILLING DISPUTES

Any open invoices will be closed by office staff at the end of the show with the method of payment holding the entry. To assist you in the Covid-19 limited office procedures, you may request bills to be printed in advance by emailing Hali Miller at casey255@gmail.com. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to review their bill and resolve any discrepancies within 24 hours of the show ending. If disputes are not negotiated within this time frame the bill will stand as is without any further review.

NON-NEGOTIABLE FUNDS

Any non-negotiable funds will be charged a \$100 processing fee per occurrence plus up to 1.5% interest per month. This includes returned checks and declined credit cards.

REFUND & CREDIT CARD POLICY

Stabling, nominating and administration fees will not be refunded under any circumstances. Horses entered may be scratched without a veterinarian's certificate by notifying the Show Secretary in writing on an official scratch sheet. Written notification is received before the start of competition, entry fees will be refunded, less a \$150 processing fee. We encourage you or your agent/trainer to close out your show bill online before the end of the show. If you do not close out your own account, you automatically agree to authorize South Florida Hunter Jumper Association to charge your credit card for all entry fees, stabling fees, etc. If you dispute a charge made by South Florida Hunter Jumper Association you may not be able to show until the charge dispute has been resolved.

AIR VESTS

Air vest are allowed (and encouraged) in all disciplines. For Hunter and Equitation Classes Judges are instructed not to deduct points for the use of air vest worn over coats. Please note that the show will not be delayed in order to reset air vests. Riders who choose to wear air vests are therefore strongly encouraged to have spare equipment (air canisters, tethers and entire vests) so that vest that have been inflated can quickly be returned to their operation. Please look for air canister recycling containers located at participating Air Vest vendors.

HUNTER & EQUITATION ATTIRE

Proper riding attire is required: boots, breeches, riding jacket, shirt with choker or tie. Riders must wear coats in all classes unless otherwise announced. It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions, when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured GR801. PLEASE MAKE YOURSELF AWARE OF ALL JUMPER ATTIRE RULES PRINTED IN THIS PRIZE LIST. **A participant may choose to wear a facemask or face covering when mounted on a horse and cannot be disqualified or penalized for doing so while competing. Please remember that showing in Florida heat is very taxing on your body. Please make sure that you take this under consideration when making this decision. Please stay extra hydrated and wear devices (if you so choose) that do not contribute to heat-related illnesses such as Heat Exhaustion or Heat Stroke.

COMPETITION FEES

GR208.1 Competition Fees. For every horse participating in any competition licensed by the Federation, a \$23 Federation fee will be collected (\$15 Equine Drugs and Medication fee to provide for research, inspection, and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see GR407.1, .2 and .3). Exception: Horses entered in classes exempted from the Equine Drugs and Medication fee are also exempt from the balance of the Federation fee. A \$7.00 Zone Support Fee per horse entered at National & Premier. An IHP fee of \$35 will be charged to each horse showing in any Computer Ranked Grand Prix.

HORSE SHOW FARRIER

No farrier other than the official horse show farrier(s) will be permitted to shoe on the grounds without the express permission of facility management. Exhibitors wishing to use another farrier must request a permit for that farrier. Proof of insurance and licenses will be required before permission is granted. Permit fees will apply.

JUMP ORDER

In order to give riders the best estimated times of when they will compete, management intends to designate an order of go for all over fences rounds. All orders will be posted online at least 30 minutes before the class and the one minute rule will be in effect. Riders that foresee conflicts must communicate with the ingate personnel involved. Do not rely on radio contact only! Riders are forewarned that the show will not be held up because of trainer conflicts. After order of go in any class is posted there will be no refunds allowed. Jumper classes with posted orders will use the following procedure in accordance with JP112.2: the horses names drawn individually, starting from the first position and then down. Please note that we will be opening up parts of the Showgrounds software that allows for participants to sign up for order assignments by time designation the day before the class. We will be sending out tutorial information on this feature and it will also be posted on our website.

MEDICAL WASTE & SHARPS

In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act which restricts the disposal of medical waste, Bio Hazardous Medical Waste Containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of this waste. Sharps will be placed in sharp containers provided. Anyone found discarding sharps in any other manner will be fined up to \$250 per instance and held responsible for any fines or expenses incurred by management. Violations to this rule will be dealt with very seriously. Improper disposal of sharps poses a serious health threat to anyone who may come in contact with it. Please make sure that anyone who handles these sharps on your behalf are aware of the responsibility involved. Neither ignorance or language will excuse fine enforcement. If you need additional containers or any assistance with the disposal of sharps, please ask the office or a member of the staff. Thank you for your cooperation.

COMPORTMENT

Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the Judges or Officials on the part of any owner, rider, trainer, family member, or groom may disqualify the horse and the owner will forfeit all entry and other fees. Please remember the SFHJA Management reserves the right to remove any individual that refuses to follow the Covid-19 protocols.

PROTEST

Any exhibitor lodging a protest must first deposit \$200.00 for USEF Members or \$300 for Non-Members with the Show Secretary, or Steward which sum will be forfeited to the show if the same is not sustained. All protests must be addressed to the Show Secretary or Steward and made in writing, signed by the protester, and filed with the Show Secretary, Show Manager or Show Steward within 48 hours. Funds must be payable to USEF. Protests may also be files with the Federation Hearing Committee as outlined in GR603.1.

2022 HORSE OF THE YEAR CHAMPIONSHIPS

MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- A. Horse owner, rider and trainer must be Active/Competing members of USHJA and USEF. Membership must be active on or before the first day of competition as outlined in the USEF rulebook.
- B. Horses must be recorded with USEF and registered with USHJA.
- C. The competition year is December 1 through November 30.

ZONE HOTY CHAMPIONSHIP

A. Competitor Qualifying Criteria

- 1. HOTY Championship classes are open to all competitors who meet the Section I Minimum Eligibility Requirements.
- B. In order to earn Zone Championship Points, the owner or recorded leasee of the horse must reside within the Zone.

1. In Hunter and Jumper sections the owner or recorded leasee of the horse must reside within the Zone in order to participate in the Zone Championship and receive Championship Points.

2. In Equitation sections the rider must reside within the Zone in order to participate in the Zone Championship and receive Championship Points.

- C. Each USHJA Zone HOTY Championship must offer a minimum of six Zone HOTY sections. Complementary sections may be combined if there are not at least three entries in each section. Please note the age groups offered may vary for each zone. All sections must be run in accordance with the Zone Specifications.

- D. Eligible riders may participate in two Championships within the same zone.

ZONE CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITION FORMAT

Hunter Section Format:

- 1. Must be offered with a minimum of two over fences classes and one under saddle as defined in HU150.
- 2. Management may designate classes of an existing section that will count for the USHJA Zone Championship Points. Additional classes are not required to be held for the USHJA Zone HOTY Championship.
- 3. Eligible exhibitors that place 1st-8th in each class will receive Zone HOTY Championship Points. Zone HOTY Championship Points will be awarded for Champion and Reserve Champion.

Jumper Section Format:

- 1. May be offered as two or three individual classes.
- 2. Management may designate classes of an existing section that will count for the USHJA Zone Championship Points. Additional classes are not required to be held for the USHJA Zone HOTY Championship.
- 3. Eligible exhibitors that place 1st-8th in each class will receive Zone HOTY Championship Points.

Equitation Section Format

- 1. Must be offered at two over fences classes and one under saddle.
- 2. Management may designate classes of an existing section that will count for the USHJA Zone Championship Points. Additional classes are not required to be held for the USHJA Zone HOTY Championship.
- 3. Eligible exhibitors that place 1st-8th in each class will receive Zone HOTY Championship Points.

Zone HOTY Championship Points will be awarded for Champion and Reserve Champion.

JUMPER ATTIRE

This will be enforced so please make sure you are dressed according to what class you are entered in.

Please be advised that exposed hoods of any kind are prohibited.

Formal Jumper Attire

Dark, muted or similar colored, or red (scarlet) coats are required; white or fawn breeches; a white tie or choker (unless the shirt by design has the choker built in for its intended use) or hunting stock, and a white or lightly colored shirt must be worn. Shirts must have a white collar and white cuffs. Shirts must be fastened at the neck and tucked in. Boots are required. Half chaps are permitted as long as the color matches the paddock boots being worn. Members of the Armed Services or the police may wear the service dress uniform with protective headgear (See General Rules, GR 801.2).

Classes requiring Formal Attire are any Grand Prix or Special classes offering at least \$25,000 in prize money.

Proper Jumper Attire

Coats of any color are required. Breeches must be a light color (white, fawn or canary). Pastel and dark colored breeches are not allowed. Shirts, light in color, must be tucked in and fastened at the top of the neck. Ties or chokers of any color must be worn (unless the shirt, by design, has the choker built in for its intended use). Boots are required. Half chaps are permitted as long as the color matches the paddock boots being worn.

Classes requiring Proper Attire are any Classic or Stakes class.

Standard Jumper Attire

Coats are not required. Breeches of any color are permitted. Shirts (polo shirts are permitted) must have collars and sleeves (sleeves may be either long or short), and must be tucked into the breeches. Sleeveless shirts and shirts with exposed hoods are prohibited. Boots are required. Half chaps are permitted as long as the color matches the paddock boots being worn.

All other classes will require Standard Attire.

In extreme weather conditions the use of jackets, sweaters or raincoats, without exposed hoods, can be allowed by management and/or permission from the jumper jury. Permission must be granted before entering the ring.

In case where the above requirements are not followed the penalty will either be a possible warning (for the first offense) or elimination. Please note that competitors are responsible for their own clothing. A wardrobe malfunction (e.g., magnets, zippers, buttons breaking) is not an excuse for improper attire.

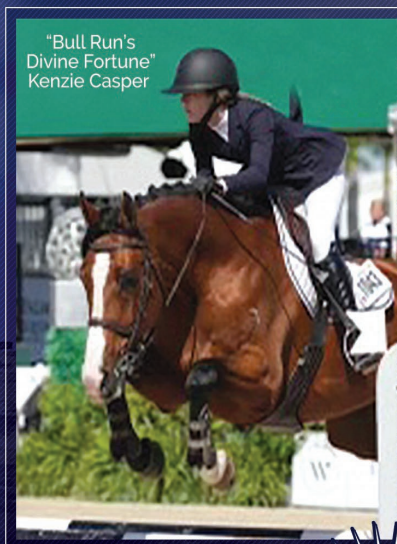

SPECIAL CLASSES

Eligibility

Exhibitors are responsible for knowledge of the rules pertaining to eligibility and entry restrictions for these Special Classes. Any exhibitor who competes and is then determined to be in violation of eligibility will forfeit their placing, award, and prize money. No refund of entry fees will be made. National Standard will be used in cases where it applies.

Jumper Nomination Fee

Special Jumper classes of \$2,000 or more in prize money will have an additional \$50 Special Class Nomination Fee. If only entering the classic and not doing the regular classes of the division a \$50 nomination fee will be charged (for \$2,000 Classics), \$100 for all other classics.. Maximum of \$100 nomination per entry.

Membership

Membership in any league is not required to compete in these classes. However, membership is required for points to count with the leagues.

Post Entry

Once an order of go is established, a post entry will be required to go at the top of the order. Any entry in a special class not received by 4pm the day before the class, (Exception: Grand Prix must be entered prior to the 24 hour check in) will be considered a post entry & the post fee listed will be charged.

Refunds

Any class that has a required number of entries that is not met, and is cancelled will entitle all entry & nomination fees to be refunded. If exhibitors elects to compete in a 75% add back class in place of the special class the entry fees will be distributed to the winners at 40%,30%,20%,10% to 1st to 4th place respectively. For any \$5,000 or more class - If after the order is posted but prior to the first horse on course, a rider feels he must scratch he will be eligible for 50% of the entry fee only for that class.

Scratches

Any class with more than one round may not be scratched for any reason after the first round has begun. If a special class is scratched the day before the class is scheduled a full refund will be given. If a class is scratched on the day of the class but prior to the start, a \$25 process fee or the nomination fee, whichever is greater, will be charged, Except in case of \$5,000 or higher classes the above refund rule will apply.

Awards

II. ELIGIBILITY - I. The rider must be a USHJA Zone 4 member in good standing. 2. Eligibility for the divisions follows Zone 4 specifications. <https://www.ushja.org/zones-affiliates/zone-4/specifications>

III. QUALIFYING PROCEDURES - Riders do not have to apply prior to the show. Riders must enter the Zone 4 Hunter Team Challenge by 3 PM on Friday in order for management to draw teams. The entry fee for the Challenge is \$75.

IV. NUMBER & COMPOSITION OF TEAMS - Teams are determined by random draw, and are made up of a maximum of four (4) and minimum of three (3) horse and rider combinations. Ideally, teams will be comprised equally of 3' and 2'6" riders until all spaces are filled. Management has the final decision on the composition and combination of the teams. Teams will be identified by color (red team, blue team, etc.), and the option to braid in colored yarn or other team spirit is encouraged and will not be penalized in the rider's regular division.

V. TEAM CHALLENGE MEETING- There will be a team challenge meeting that is mandatory for all riders on Friday evening. Teams will be announced and questions answered. Riders are then invited to socialize and get to know each other at the show party that evening.

VI. TEAM CHALLENGE FORMAT AND SCORING:

Day One- Team Challenge Riders will compete in their regular division classes on Day One. Each rider will be given a numerical score in each of their regular division two over fences classes on Day One, and those numerical scores will be added together to determine their Team's Score from Day One. Four-member teams will drop their lowest scoring rider from each class. Three-member teams will drop the lowest scoring rider from each class and double the second lowest scoring rider's score. This will ensure that all teams have the benefit of a dropped score.

Day Two- On Day Two, the top six (6)- eight (8) teams with the highest Team Scores from Day One are invited to compete in the Final Round, **which will be imbedded within their respective classic class (Class 902 Children Hunter, 904 Adult Hunter, 900 Low Adult Hunter & 901 Low Children's Hunter)**. -Numerical scores will be given to each rider in the Final Round. The score given to the highest scoring rider from each team will be doubled and then added to the Team Score from Day One to determine the Team's Final Overall Score for the purpose of awards. The Awards presentation will immediately follow the conclusion of the Final Round on Day Two. Riders may complete their regular division classes as scheduled at the conclusion of the awards presentation.

VII. OVERALL TEAM CHAMPIONS - The Team Champion is the Team with the highest Total Score after the Final Round. In the case of a tie for any top-six overall team placing, the team with the single highest score from the Final Challenge Round will break the tie.

VIII. HIGH SCORING AMATEUR AND JUNIOR RIDERS - The one amateur rider and one junior rider who receive the highest total combined score from the three phases will be named High Scoring Amateur and High Scoring Junior riders of the Challenge. For the purpose of determining the high scoring amateur and junior rider, scores from the Final Round will not be doubled. In the case of a tie, the rider with the highest score from the Final Challenge Round will be the tie breaker and will be named the High Score rider.

IX. AWARDS - Ribbons 1-6 to Teams Overall. Coolers to the Champion Team. High Scoring Amateur rider and High Scoring Junior rider will receive embroidered coolerettes.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "**Agreement**"):

A. **RULES AND REGULATIONS:** I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK:** I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("**Risks**").
