


incidental to the game of polo and expressly acknowledge that an inherent risk of exposure.

TOURNAMENT HISTORY

The Ylvisaker Cup is played annually as a tribute to William T. "Bill" Ylvisaker, a true pioneer who was responsible for developing the Wellington, Florida, area into the high-goal winter polo capital of the world. Ylvisaker contributed extensively to the sport's resurgence in the 70s and 80s. Out of the unwelcoming, wild and forbidding marsh on the edge of the Florida Everglades he created the Palm Beach Polo and Country Club. Palm Beach Polo Club flourished and the town of Wellington sprung up around it, going on to successfully host not only polo but numerous other equestrian sports.

As for Ylvisaker's personal playing record, he began with two National Interscholastic Championships in the 40s, continuing his polo career at Yale University, ultimately reaching a 7-goal handicap at the height of his career. His notable wins include a 1972 U.S. Open Polo Championship® victory, a USPA Gold Cup® and two

Coronation Cup titles (Great Britain versus United States), among many others. Ylvisaker co-founded the Polo Training Foundation (PTF) in 1967 and served as its first Vice President. He also served as Chairman of the USPA from 1970 to 1975. He was inducted into the Museum of Polo and Hall of Fame in 1996.

Established in 2003, the Ylvisaker Cup has been exclusively played at the International Polo Club Palm Beach in Wellington, Florida. Over the past decade the popular tournament has fielded rosters of up to 16 teams. New Bridge-La Dolfina captured back-to-back wins in 2006 and 2007, the only consecutive wins by one team in the history of the tournament. Coca-Cola is another staple of the Ylvisaker Cup with recent victories in 2015 and 2017. This year's tournament will feature four competitive teams including Aspen, Beverly Polo, Palm Beach Equine and Tamera.



PLAYER PROFILE Hilario Figueras

Competing throughout the 18goal season at the International Polo Club Palm Beach (IPC) with Beverly Polo, Hilario Figueras welcomed the new year with a good start after Beverly Polo managed to reach the Joe Barry Memorial final and has earned a spot in the semifinal round of the 2021 Ylvisaker Cup slated for Thursday, February 4th. Increased to a 4-goal handicap in 2021, Figueras has justified the increase, leading Beverly Polo in goals for both the Ylvisaker Cup and 18-goal season. Given the responsibility



of taking Beverly Polo's Penalty 2 and 3 attempts, Figueras has been a perfect 9 for 9 in the Ylvisaker Cup, a trend he will look to continue entering the semifinal against Tamera.

One of the youngest players in the season at just 20 years of age, Figueras comes from a polo-playing family as the son of Ignacio "Nacho" Figueras, a notable player and figure in polo. Prior to joining Beverly Polo for the 2021 18-goal season, his first major season of high-goal play at IPC, Figueras competed in notable seasons in Santa Barbara as

well as recently in Virginia with Bill Ballhaus and the Beverly Equestrian organization. Figueras is familiar playing alongside both Ballhaus and Tolito Ocampo, including in 2018 where they were finalists in the \$50,000 National 12-Goal Tournament. Although still in the early stages of his career, Figueras can add the 2020 Aspen Snow Polo World Championship to his resume, winning the title with World Polo League.

Building each year on his experiences, Figueras has excelled for Beverly Polo, ranking third

among all players in scoring with 20 goals in the Joe Barry and Ylvisaker Cup, an impressive feat playing amongst higher-rated players. While his focus in open play can be on the defensive side of the ball in the #4 position, he has pushed towards the top of the scoring list with 75% of his goals coming from the penalty line. Figueras' impact for Beverly Polo has been in his consistency, gaining possession with 12 throw-in wins, ranking second on the team, while avoiding fouling by committing just three fouls through three games in the Ylvisaker Cup.



POLO SCHOOL at International Polo Club



The International Polo School is in full swing this season, entering its fourth year. The school is a full-service operation; offering lessons, stabling, four, six, and 8 goal leagues, coaching leagues, and horse leasing. The IPS also offers practice memberships which allow sponsors and their professionals to practice twice a week from January through April.

The School now offers 150+ stalls for rent which includes turnout, access to exercise tracks, and a

full-length stick and ball field. Gates Gridley and Ignacio "Nacho" Cabrera have built the program from 10 horses and 100 lessons in 2017 to 28 horses and over 600 lessons in 2020. The School operates from Tuesday through Sunday from October through May and has a string of horses that can accomodate any level of riding, whether you are a beginner looking to try a new sport, or an experienced player looking to participate in practices, leagues, or stick and ball.


